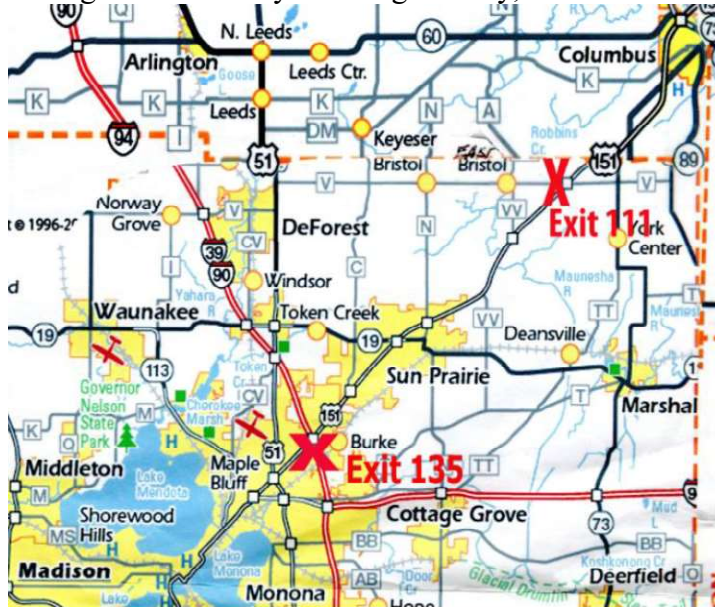

From I-90/94/39 take Exit 135 to Sun Prairie

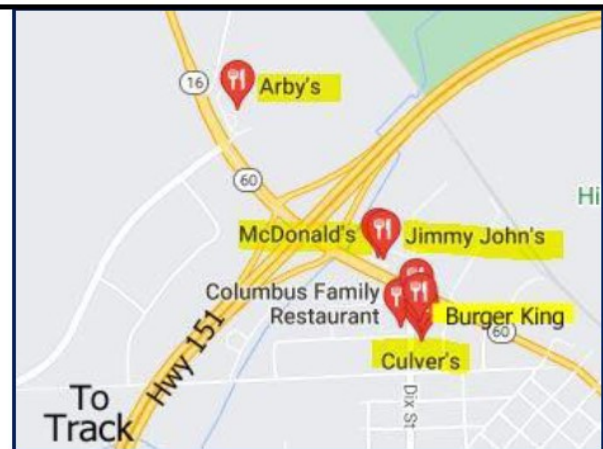
For all take Exit 111 (County V) West Krause Rd is the VERY 1st right off V west of the 151/V Interchange
